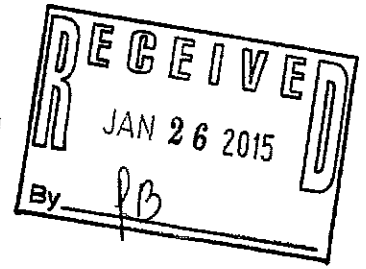

**Re: Analysis & Funding for a Limited Access Roadway for Southern Volusia County**

Dear Ms. Bollenback:

The City of Deltona is regionally focused on Volusia County's transportation network in working with Volusia County, the River to Sea Transportation Planning Organization (TPO), the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), the Volusia County School Board, the Volusia Growth Management Commission (VGMC), and the East Central Florida Regional Planning Council (ECFRPC), to provide for regional interconnectivity.

As you know, there is no limited access system-to-system facility linking our regional interstate system within southern Volusia County, although there is a critical need for that additional connector between Interstate 95 to Interstate 4. With three interchanges along Interstate 4, Deltona is geographically located to facilitate that connector. A few regional benefits for the facility include providing for a coastal evacuation route, regional economic development, energy conservation, employment opportunities, etc.

To-date, Deltona has been involved in regional planning efforts through the TPO, the FDOT, and the ECFRPC, in discussing the need for an interconnected limited-access facility in southern Volusia County. We also understand that there is funding available for a feasibility study for that to be located somewhere between SR 44 and SR 46, (with funding commitment for the roadway design needed shortly).



**RESOLUTION 2015-03**

**RESOLUTION OF THE RIVER TO SEA TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION  
MAINTAINING A RAIL ENVELOPE ALONG INTERSTATE 4 THROUGHOUT THE  
METROPOLITAN PLANNING AREA (MPA)**

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**WHEREAS**, Florida Statutes 339.175; 23 U.S.C. 134; and 49 U.S.C. 5303 require that the urbanized area, as a condition to the receipt of federal capital or operating assistance, have a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process that results in plans and programs consistent with the comprehensively planned development of the urbanized area; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 134, 49 U.S.C. 5303, 23 CFR 450.310, and Florida Statutes 339.175, the River to Sea Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) is the duly designated and constituted body responsible for carrying out the urban transportation planning process and programming process for Volusia County and portions of Flagler County inclusive of the cities of Flagler Beach, Beverly Beach, and portions of Palm Coast and Bunnell; and

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is conducting a Project Development and Environmental (PD&E) study to expand I-4 to include the addition of managed use lanes extending from the western boundary of the Metropolitan Planning Area (MPA) into the planning area; and

**WHEREAS**, FDOT is seeking input from the TPO regarding the preservation of a rail envelope to accommodate future passenger rail service and regarding the preferred limits of the project based on engineering scenarios presented to the TPO; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the River to Sea TPO that:

1. The Florida Department of Transportation should continue to preserve the right-of-way needed for the future development of passenger rail service within the I-4 corridor extending throughout the Metropolitan Planning Area (MPA) from SR 46 eastward to I-95 (based on a logical termini); and
2. The preferred option, based on the four scenarios presented to the TPO Board, includes extending two express lanes in each direction from the western boundary of the MPA eastward to an extension of Rhode Island Avenue;

3. Chairperson of the TPO (or his designee) is hereby authorized and directed to submit FY 2014/15 - FY 2018/19 TIP to the:
  - a. Florida Department of Transportation;
  - b. Federal Transit Administration (FTA) (through the Florida Department of Transportation);
  - c. Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) (through the Florida Department of Transportation);
  - d. Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) (through the Florida Department of Transportation); and the
  - e. East Central Florida Regional Planning Council (ECFRPC).

I am writing to you on behalf of the Central Florida MPO Alliance to request that federal funding for SunRail Phase II-North (\$37.5 million, 50% of the project's costs) be included in the President's Fiscal Year 2016 budget.

The Central Florida MPO Alliance is comprised of six metropolitan planning organizations representing 10 counties here in Central Florida. Our focus is on regional transportation policy issues and projects of true regional significance. SunRail is one such project.


A tremendous amount of work has gone into the SunRail project over the years. This is the region's first regional rail transit project. Initial controversies from years ago over a new means of mobility have given way to widespread enthusiasm for more rail transit service.

Looking at future possibilities is visionary planning, but our immediate focus is on the completion of the 61-mile project as originally planned. This includes Phase II-North to the DeLand Station in Volusia County.

This project qualifies under the "Small Starts Program" - but contrary to the name for this program, SunRail Phase II-North qualifies as a big deal for us here in Central Florida. It means fulfilling a commitment that was made by regional leaders to see the project through to completion.

FTA has been a wonderful partner in the development of the SunRail project. We are now asking for your help with getting the federal funding component in place to get work underway on Phase II-North -- the final 12-mile segment of the original project.
