I. Call to Order / Roll Call / Determination of Quorum / Pledge of Allegiance

The meeting of the River to Sea Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) Executive Director Search Committee was called to order at 10:32 a.m. by Chairperson Billie Wheeler. The roll was called and it was determined that a quorum was physically present. Due to the COVID-19 virus, the meeting was held in a hybrid format with seven voting members physically present.

II. <u>Public Comment/Participation</u>

There were no public comments.

III. Business Items

A. <u>Review and Approval of November 17, 2021 Executive Director Search Committee Meeting Minutes</u>

MOTION: A motion was made by Commissioner McGuirk to approve the November 17, 2021 Executive Director Search Committee meeting minutes. The motion was seconded by Council Member Girtman and carried unanimously.

B. <u>Review and Approval of Strategic Government Resources (SGR) Contract Extension</u>

Ms. Nicoulin explained that the current contract with SGR expires January 31, 2022; when the TPO initially contracted with SGR in August 2021, it was thought that the process would be completed by then. Realistically, the process will not be completed by that time and the contract needs to be extended through April 1, 2022; the contract allows an extension as long as both parties agree.

Commissioner Cloudman asked if the extension is for terms of service and does not incur any additional costs. Ms. Nicoulin replied yes, that is correct.

MOTION: A motion was made by Mayor Partington approve the Strategic Government Resources (SGR) contract extension through April 1, 2022. The motion was seconded by Councilwoman Power and carried unanimously.

C. Executive Director Candidate Review and Selection of Semifinalists

Mr. Doug Thomas, SGR, stated the goal today is to select between eight to twelve candidates as semifinalists from the candidate pool of 18 cover letters and resumes received for the Executive Director position.

Council Member Girtman asked if any of the candidates were ones he pursued to recruit or if they all applied from the advertised position.

Mr. Thomas replied resumes were received from the national and regional ad postings as well as the people he reached out to; he contacted approximately 800 people. The 18 resumes received were all qualified candidates and met or exceeded the position requirements. He reviewed the recruiting process conducted and explained how the position was marketed. He reviewed the demographics of the candidates, their credentials and their geographic locations.

Members discussed the responses received and asked questions regarding re-advertising the position or extending the open application process. Members also discussed allowing Mr. Thomas to narrow the candidate pool to the top eight or ten applicants as semifinalists. After much discussion, a consensus was reached to leave the application process open through the end of January and to reconvene the EDSC on Monday, February 7, 2022 at 9:30 am to review the candidates.
