Members discussed the population projections provided by the Bureau of Economic and Business Research (BEBR). It was asked if the prior LRTPs were ever reviewed for accuracy, and Ms. Karl stated that she could provide that information after looking into it. The timeline of the prioritization list was broached, and Ms. Nicoulin stated that the prioritization criteria will be brought back next month as an action item and that more details will be provided. It was also asked how to get specific project visibility. Ms. Nicoulin suggested using the interactive dashboard that would be available later this month or attending one of the TPO's open houses to provide specific concerns.

B. FDOT Report

Ms. Powell reviewed the FDOT report and provided announcements from FDOT's Safety Office, stating that in District 5, there was a 15% decrease in fatalities, which equates to over 110 lives. She also announced an inaugural transportation industry hiring event on April 30th at Osceola Heritage Park, and the FDOT's Central Florida Safety Summit taking place at the Daytona International Speedway on May 9th.

Ms. Nicoulin further explained the Central Florida Safety Summit, noting the TPO was involved in the planning of the event, and she encouraged members to attend.

C. Volusia and Flagler County Construction Reports

The Volusia County and Flagler County Construction Reports were provided in the agenda.

5. Staff Comments

Ms. Nicoulin reminded the committee that the Call for Projects is open until March 31st at 4:00 pm, after which TPO staff will review the applications and the TIP Subcommittee meeting will be held.

Mr. Harris announced upcoming Vision Zero Action Plan community workshops taking place on March 20th in DeLand, April 3rd in Daytona Beach, and April 17th in Palm Coast. There will also be a Vision Zero Action Plan Working Group meeting next Wednesday.

Ms. Karl circled back to the discussion about reviewing past LRTPs for accuracy, stating that the travel demand model is revised based on previous data.


