1. Call to Order / Roll Call / Determination of Quorum/Pledge of Allegiance

Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) Chairperson Greg Feldman called the meeting of the Volusia-Flagler Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) to order at 1:15 p.m. The roll was called, and it was determined that a quorum was physically present. The meeting was held in a hybrid format with twelve voting members and one non-voting member physically present, and three voting members and one non-voting member virtually present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given.

MOTION: *Mr. Storke made a motion to allow virtual participation. The motion was seconded by Ms. Deyette and carried unanimously.*

2. Public Comment/Participation

There were no public comments.

3. Action Items

A. Review and Approval of the April 21, 2026 CAC Meeting Minutes

MOTION: *Mr. Persad moved to approve the April 21, 2026 CAC minutes. The motion was seconded by Mr. Storke and carried unanimously.*

B. Nomination and Election of CAC/TCC Officers for FY 2026/27

Ms. Nicoulin explained that each year, the TPO's committees must elect officers to serve a one-year term. This fiscal year, the term will begin July 1, 2026, and end June 30, 2027. Officers may not serve more than two consecutive terms. Mr. Greg Feldman and Mr. Paul Mykytka have both served one year as Chair and Vice Chair, respectively.

MOTION: *Ms. Deyette made a motion to nominate and reelect Mr. Feldman and Mr. Mykytka as the CAC Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson respectively for FY 2026/27. The motion was seconded by Mr. Persad and carried unanimously.*

4. Presentation Items

A. Presentation and Discussion of the Draft 2026 List of Prioritized Projects (LOPP)

Ms. Nicoulin stated that every year, the LOPP is updated. She noted that the link in the agenda will be populated on Friday, May 22nd after the TIP Subcommittee meets to review and rank the applications received.. She explained the priority project process and how it ties into the TIP. She added that there will be a 30-day public comment period for the LOPP.

B. Presentation and Discussion of the Draft FY 2026/27 to FY 2030/31 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

Ms. Nicoulin explained that the annual update to the TIP is currently being developed. She explained that the document encompasses all funded projects over the next five years in both counties. She specified that the projects listed are not solely the TPO's, but all projects including aviation, landscape, maintenance, resurfacing, etc. She stated that staff is currently putting together the draft document to post for a 30-day public review period beginning Friday, May 22nd. She went over the specific bicycle/pedestrian projects in the TIP. She pointed out a correction in the document, stating that FY 2026 should state FY 2027 for the Ponce Inlet Mobility project. She highlighted SUN Trail projects and funding as well as the Traffic Operations/Safety projects. She noted that the narrative section is being rewritten this year to be more user-friendly to read and to be consistent with the other TPO plans. She asked members to let staff know of any questions or comments during the review period.

Discussion ensued regarding the rollover amendment.

Ms. Nicoulin explained the process of submitting the TIP to FDOT.

Mr. Mykytka asked what type of feedback staff is looking for. Ms. Nicoulin explained that if someone sees a specific project that is a priority that has not moved into the TIP, projects that should be considered for funding, or if funding amounts or years are incorrect, to let staff know.

C. FDOT Report

Ms. Powell presented the FDOT Report; she highlighted recently completed projects, an upcoming project, and offered a reminder that May is Youth Traffic Safety Month.

D. Volusia and Flagler County Construction Reports

The Volusia County and Flagler County Construction Reports were provided in the agenda.

5. Staff Comments

Ms. Nicoulin announced that Mr. Harris is celebrating his 20-year anniversary with the TPO this month and recognized his hard work.

6. CAC Member Comments

Mr. Williams asked how best to look up the Pioneer Trail and I-95 project. Ms. Powell advised checking CFLroads.com.

Mr. Persad stated that VoTran was proposing changes to service including the installation of a new bus stop on Cornerstone Boulevard, which would become effective June 28th.


