1. Call to Order / Roll Call / Determination of Quorum/Pledge of Allegiance

Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) Chairperson Greg Feldman called the meeting of the Volusia-Flagler Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) to order at 1:16 p.m. The roll was called, and it was determined that a quorum was physically present. The meeting was held in a hybrid format with ten voting members and one non-voting member physically present, and one voting member virtually present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given.

MOTION: *Mr. Storke made a motion to allow virtual participation. The motion was seconded by Ms. Power and carried unanimously.*

There were no public comments.

3. Action Items

A. Review and Approval of the May 19, 2026 CAC Meeting Minutes

MOTION: *Mr. Persad moved to approve the May 19, 2026 CAC minutes. The motion was seconded by Mr. MacFarlane and carried unanimously.*

B. Review and Recommend Approval of Resolution 2026-## adopting the FY 2026/27 to FY 2030/31 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) (Roll Call Vote Required)

Ms. Nicoulin explained the purpose of the TIP and went over the timeline of submittal to FDOT. She explained the connection between the TIP and FDOT's Tentative Work Program. She stated that the public review period is still open and will close on June 22nd. The TIP is expected to be uploaded to FDOT by July 15th.

Chairperson Feldman encouraged members to look at the TIP during the public comment period and stated that he had submitted comments and shared the information on his Facebook page.

MOTION: *Mr. Storke made a motion to recommend approval of Resolution 2026-## adopting the FY 2026/27 to FY 2030/31 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The motion was seconded by Ms. Deyette and carried unanimously by roll call vote.*

C. Review and Recommend Approval of Resolution 2026-## adopting the Volusia-Flagler TPO 2026 List of Prioritized Projects (LOPP)

Ms. Nicoulin explained the purpose of the LOPP and explained that the first three lists of projects come from the 2050 LRTP. She explained the changes including deletions and updated cost estimates. Some minor changes have been made since the prior month but the rankings remain the same.

Members discussed a project on Old Mission Road in Edgewater and how this project is titled and included in the LOPP. Ms. Nicoulin stated that the project would need to be coordination between Edgewater and New Smyrna Beach because of the location.

Ms. Power added that trucks are taking Glencoe Road to get into Parktown Industrial Park; a right lane on SR 44 to Mission Road would be an effective precursor to the project. Ms. Karl added that FDOT has said they will be adding the lane and putting it in. Ms. Nicoulin noted she would follow up.

Chairperson Feldman stated that he received a request from Bunnell Police Chief Brannon regarding expediting the installation of a traffic signal project on SR 100 and Commerce Parkway in Bunnell.

MOTION: *Mr. Persad made a motion to recommend approval of Resolution 2026-## adopting the Volusia-Flagler TPO 2026 List of Priority Projects. The motion was seconded by Mr. Storke and carried unanimously.*

He described the public outreach efforts; press releases, public meetings, and comment cards, and stated that final council approval will take place that day.

Members discussed situations where VoRide can be used.

Mr. Persad stated that many changes will go into effect on June 28th with the remainder to begin in October. He described the difference between VoRide and Flex.

Ms. Powell presented the FDOT Report; she shared upcoming projects and the completion of the two-lane roundabout on Kepler Road in DeLand. With hurricane season beginning, she shared a video regarding FDOT's emergency response efforts. She announced that this will be her last meeting as the FDOT Liaison as she has accepted another job opportunity.

SUMMARY BACKGROUND:

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) requests approval of an amendment to the FY 2026/27 to FY 2030/31 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to include projects with funds rolling forward from FY 2025/26 to FY 2026/27. Each year, FDOT develops the tentative Five-Year Work Program, which becomes effective on July 1st. The TPO incorporates the tentative Work Program into the new Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), which was adopted by the TPO Board on June 24, 2026, and became effective on July 1st. Year 1 of the TIP and the Work Program should always match. However, when the new TIP and Work Program became effective on July 1st, there were projects that were supposed to be authorized prior to June 30th but were not (i.e., when the previous TIP and Work Program were in effect). These projects will automatically roll forward in the Work Program, but not in the TIP. Hence, there is a need to reconcile the two documents and bring the new TIP up-to-date. This is accomplished through a routine procedure that is processed every year, known as a “roll forward” TIP amendment. This roll forward amendment request ensures that the projects shown in the TIP are consistent with the projects shown in FDOT’s Five-Year Work Program.

The proposed amendment is authorized in Resolution 2026-## and incorporates the projects with funding that rolled forward from FY 2025/26 to FY 2026/27 into the FY 2026/27 to FY 2030/31 TIP. A summary of the projects included in the Roll Forward Project Report is provided in Attachment A and the full report is accessible through the link provided below.

WHEREAS, the River to Sea Transportation Planning Organization, DBA the Volusia-Flagler Transportation Planning Organization (TPO), is the duly designated and constituted body responsible for carrying out the urban transportation planning and programming process for Volusia County and Flagler County; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes 339.175; 23 U.S.C. 134; and 49 U.S.C. 5303 require that the urbanized area, as a condition to the receipt of federal capital or operating assistance, have a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process that results in plans and programs consistent with the comprehensively planned development of the urbanized area; and

WHEREAS, the Volusia-Flagler TPO shall annually endorse and amend as appropriate, the plans and programs required by 23 C.F.R. 450.300 through 450.324, among which is the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and

WHEREAS, the Volusia-Flagler TPO's adopted TIP is required to be consistent with the Florida Department of Transportation's adopted Five-Year Work Program; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation has provided additional information to the Volusia-Flagler TPO regarding the FDOT adopted Five-Year Work Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Volusia-Flagler TPO that the:

1. Volusia-Flagler TPO's FY 2026/27 to FY 2030/31 TIP is hereby amended as shown in Attachment "A" attached hereto and made a part of this resolution; and the
2. Chairperson of the Volusia-Flagler TPO (or their designee) is hereby authorized and directed to submit the FY 2026/27 to FY 2030/31 TIP as amended to the:
 - a. Florida Department of Transportation;
 - b. Federal Transit Administration (FTA) (through the Florida Department of Transportation); and the
 - c. Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) (through the Florida Department of Transportation).

WHEREAS, the TPO shall endorse and amend as appropriate, the plans and programs required by 23 C.F.R. 450.300 through 450.324 and Florida Statutes 339.175, among which is the Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP); and

WHEREAS, the Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) is a two-year work plan that identifies federal funding available to the TPO including metropolitan planning funds (PL Funds) authorized under 23 USC 104(f), Section 5305(d) transit planning funds and Urban Attributable (SU) funds; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2026/27 and FY 2027/28 UPWP was developed and approved by the TPO Board on April 22, 2026; and

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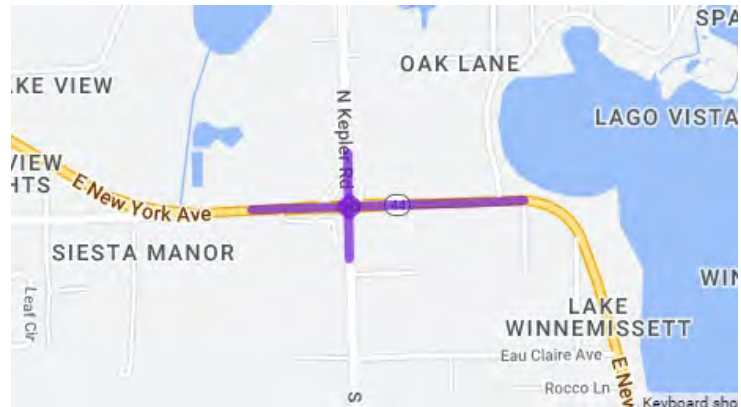

Once completed, the roundabout will replace the existing signalized intersection. It will feature two travel lanes in each direction, right-turn bypass lanes at three of the four road connections, a concrete apron to accommodate large trucks, and landscaping in the center island.

Pedestrian safety enhancements will include new sidewalks and crosswalks equipped with Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs) at the roundabout approaches. Flagler County Design & Construction Projects Report

July 2026

Road & Bridge Program

- Walnut Avenue Paving Project – Design and permitting phase is complete and has been accepted by FDOT. Project closeout underway.
- Jungle Hut Road from A1A to beach access – FDOT complete review of 100% design and issued formal acceptance of plan submittal. Plans finalization and permitting are complete as of March 2026.
- Forest Park Street from CR 90 to SR 100 – 90% design plans under review.
- CR 205 Resurfacing Project – Required design update was finalized in preparation of construction contractor procurement. Funding Agreement was approved by the BOCC on December 15, 2025. Project was advertised for Bid as 26-ITB-005 on OpenGov.com with bids received on May 20, 2026. Bid Award and supplemental funding agreement approval is scheduled for BOCC approval on August 3, 2026. Construction is anticipated to begin in September 2026 with Final Completion anticipated in March 2027.
- CR 304 Resurfacing Project (CR 305 to SR-11) – Design Plans update and permit activities are anticipated to begin in the 3rd quarter 2026. Construction is anticipated to commence in the 2nd quarter 2027.
- First Avenue Phase 2 Drainage – Design and permitting phase is complete. Construction procurement to begin in 2nd quarter of 2026 with construction anticipated to commence in 4th quarter of 2026.

Sidewalk & Trail Program

- Bulow Creek Headwaters Regional Park –The Final Master Plan and Report will be received by July 31, 2026, concluding the planning phase. Coordination with FDOT and Consultant is underway to procure services for the design and permitting phase of the project.
- Trailhead for GST & Lehigh Trail – Coordination with the Department's CSC is underway and is being coordinated with planned Eco-Discovery Center. Design phase is anticipated to begin around September 2026.



- Old Kings Road South Trail (SR100 to County Line) – 90% design is under review. Coordination with utilities is ongoing. Design is progressing towards final submittal. Final completion of design and permitting is anticipated by November 2026.

Vertical CIP Program

- Fire Rescue Station 51 – Construction Notice to Proceed was issued on November 19, 2025. Groundbreaking ceremony was held on December 8, 2025, 11am-12pm. Contractor continues with construction.
- Fire Rescue Administration Station 50 – Construction Notice to Proceed was issued on October 8, 2025. Groundbreaking ceremony was held on November 13, 2025, 10-11am. Contractor continues with construction.
- SMA Integrated Stabilization Unit – Construction Notice to Proceed was issued on October 22, 2025. Groundbreaking ceremony was held on November 18, 2025, 1-2pm. Contractor continues with construction.
- Eco-Discovery Center – Design kick-off meeting held on January 26, 2026. Design-Builder 30% Design submittal is under review.
- Multipurpose Emergency Preparedness Project – Task Work Order Four was issued to Design Build Team. This is the final Task Work Order needed to complete construction of all remaining work by June 30, 2026. Contractor completed all major work items. Punch list issued and contractor working on remaining items to obtain certificate of occupancy.

Stormwater Master Plan Program

- MalaCompra Canal Restoration and Resiliency – Design and Permitting phases are underway. Conceptual design phase was completed. Project completion is anticipated in July 2027.

Beach Management Plan Program

- Beach Reach 2 (North 7th St to Varn Park) – The Reach II Beach Nourishment Project will place ~1.8 million cubic yards of sand on 5.5 miles of beach from 2,000' North of Varn Park south to tie in to the USACE Flagler County Coastal Storm Risk Management Project in the vicinity of 7th Street North. Weeks Marine submitted the lowest price bid



May 7, and the Board of County Commissioners approved issuing a contract to Weeks for \$34 million at their August 3 meeting. Construction will likely begin in Mid-February. The contract will specify that the dredge project must be complete within 365 days from Notice to Proceed, but the actual construction should last 4 – 6 months.

- Beach Reach 3 (Varn Park to Washington Oaks) – The Professional Services Agreement with Moffatt & Nichol was approved by the BOCC on April 21, 2025. Field work for permitting studies continues and project design activities are actively underway. Hardbottom mapping has been delayed pending favorable water clarity anticipated between June 15 and July 15, 2026. The completion of the hardbottom survey will be useful for planning and permitting, but existing data indicates the extent of protected habitat will prevent pumping sand onto the beach from offshore and limit design options.
- Hammock Dunes Emergency Dune Restoration Project (Varn Park to Jungle Hut Park) – Completed as of November 2025.
- Ocean Hammock/Hammock Beach and Golf Resort Emergency Dune Restoration Project (Jungle Hut Park to MalaCompra Park) – Completed in December 2025.
- FEMA Category G Dune Restoration Project (MalaCompra Park to Washington Oaks, and Washinton Oaks to Marineland)– Completed April 2026.
