VoTran's proposal seeks funding to provide trips to transportation disadvantaged (TD) riders on VoRide, Volusia County's on-demand rideshare public transit service. **RESOLUTION OF THE VOLUSIA-FLAGLER TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION
AMENDING THE FY 2026/27 TO FY 2030/31
TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)**

WHEREAS, the River to Sea Transportation Planning Organization, DBA the Volusia-Flagler Transportation Planning Organization (TPO), is the duly designated and constituted body responsible for carrying out the urban transportation planning and programming process for Volusia County and Flagler County; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes 339.175; 23 U.S.C. 134; and 49 U.S.C. 5303 require that the urbanized area, as a condition to the receipt of federal capital or operating assistance, have a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process that results in plans and programs consistent with the comprehensively planned development of the urbanized area; and

WHEREAS, the Volusia-Flagler TPO shall annually endorse and amend as appropriate, the plans and programs required by 23 C.F.R. 450.300 through 450.324, among which is the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and

WHEREAS, the Volusia-Flagler TPO's adopted TIP is required to be consistent with the Florida Department of Transportation's adopted Five-Year Work Program; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation has provided additional information to the Volusia-Flagler TPO regarding the FDOT adopted Five-Year Work Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Volusia-Flagler TPO that the:

1. Volusia-Flagler TPO's FY 2026/27 to FY 2030/31 TIP is hereby amended as shown in Attachment "A" attached hereto and made a part of this resolution; and the
2. Chairperson of the Volusia-Flagler TPO (or their designee) is hereby authorized and directed to submit the FY 2026/27 to FY 2030/31 TIP as amended to the:
 - a. Florida Department of Transportation;
 - b. Federal Transit Administration (FTA) (through the Florida Department of Transportation); and the
 - c. Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) (through the Florida Department of Transportation).

WHEREAS, pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 134, 49 U.S.C. 5303, 23 CFR 450.310, and Florida Statutes 339.175, the River to Sea Transportation Planning Organization, DBA the Volusia-Flagler Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) is the duly designated and constituted body responsible for carrying out the urban transportation planning and programming process for Volusia County and a portion of Flagler County as defined by the Metropolitan Planning Area; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 134, 23 CFR 450, and Florida Statutes 339.175, require the TPO and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to enter into an agreement clearly identifying the responsibilities for cooperatively carrying out the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) portion of the Metropolitan Planning Process and accomplishing the transportation planning requirements of state and federal law; and

WHEREAS, the TPO shall endorse and amend as appropriate, the plans and programs required by 23 C.F.R. 450.300 through 450.324 and Florida Statutes 339.175, among which is the Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP); and

WHEREAS, the Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) is a two-year work plan that identifies federal funding available to the TPO including metropolitan planning funds (PL Funds) authorized under 23 USC 104(f), Section 5305(d) transit planning funds and Urban Attributable (SU) funds; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2026/27 and FY 2027/28 UPWP was developed and approved by the TPO Board on April 22, 2026; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the approved UPWP is required to add a work activity to Task 5.0 – Transit Related Activities and TD Program for the development of Volusia County's Major Updates to the Transit Development Plan (TDP) and Transportation Disadvantage Service Plan (TDSP).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Volusia-Flagler Transportation Planning Organization:

1. Amends Task 5.0 - Transit Related Activities and TD Program to add a work activity to support the development of Volusia County's Major Updates to the Transit Development Plan (TDP) and Transportation Disadvantage Service Plan (TDSP); and

2. Authorizes the Executive Director to execute any contracts or agreements necessary to reflect these changes.

WHEREAS, the River to Sea Transportation Planning Organization, DBA the Volusia-Flagler Transportation Planning Organization (TPO), is the duly designated and constituted body responsible for carrying out the urban transportation planning and programming process for Volusia County and Flagler County; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes 427.013 require the TPO, serving as the Designated Official Planning Agency for the Transportation Disadvantaged Program recommend, every five years, a qualified Community Transportation Coordinator (CTC) to the Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged (CTD); and

WHEREAS, the CTD Competitive Procurement Manual, compiled in accordance with Chapter 287, F.S., allows the TPO to nominate a governmental entity to serve as the CTC; and

WHEREAS, the CTC is responsible for ensuring that coordinated transportation services are provided to the transportation disadvantaged population in the designated service area of Volusia County. Accordingly, the CTC arranges for the provision of transportation services in a manner that is cost-effective, efficient, and reduces fragmentation and duplication of services; and

WHEREAS, in 1994, VoTran was designated the CTC for Volusia County and currently serves as the CTC; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Disadvantaged Local Coordinating Board has approved VoTran's FY 2025/26 Evaluation; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Disadvantaged Local Coordinating Board deems it appropriate and in the best interest of the transportation disadvantaged for VoTran to continue in its designated role as the CTC; and

WHEREAS, Volusia County deems it appropriate and in the best interest of public health, safety, and welfare for VoTran to continue in its designated role as the CTC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Volusia-Flagler TPO that the:

1. Volusia-Flagler TPO recommends the redesignation of the County of Volusia d/b/a/ VoTran as the Community Transportation Coordinator for Volusia County to the Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged; and

2. Volusia-Flagler TPO submit copies of this resolution to:
 - a. Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged;
 - b. Florida Department of Transportation;
 - c. Federal Transit Administration (through the Florida Department of Transportation);
 - d. Federal Highway Administration (through the Florida Department of Transportation);
 - e. East Central Florida Regional Planning Council; and
 - f. Volusia County.

Reauthorization 101: What Is It & Why Does It Matter?

01 What Is Reauthorization?

Congress periodically passes a multi-year law that authorizes federal surface transportation programs and sets funding levels and policy provisions for highways, transit, bridges, safety, and planning.

02 When Does It Happen?

Roughly every 5 years — though delays and extensions are common.

Past bills: SAFETEA-LU (2005), MAP-21 (2012), FAST Act (2015), IIJA/BIL (2021). Each bill shapes how federal transportation dollars flow for the following half-decade.

03 Who Writes the Bill?

Multiple House and Senate committees with jurisdiction over highways, transit, rail, safety, and finance.

The House T&I Committee leads on highway and transit policy. Revenue/tax provisions go through Ways & Means (House) and Finance (Senate).

WHY IT MATTERS

Reauthorization determines how much federal money flows to our region, which programs we can access, what we can spend it on, and how much flexibility we have in project selection. For Volusia-Flagler TPO, this bill will govern federal transportation investment for the next five years.

\$580.9 B Over 5 Years

BA250 authorizes **\$580.9B** for FY2027–2031.

This is a **4%** overall increase from the IIJA.

Highway Trust Fund covers **~\$474B**; General Fund covers **~\$107B**.

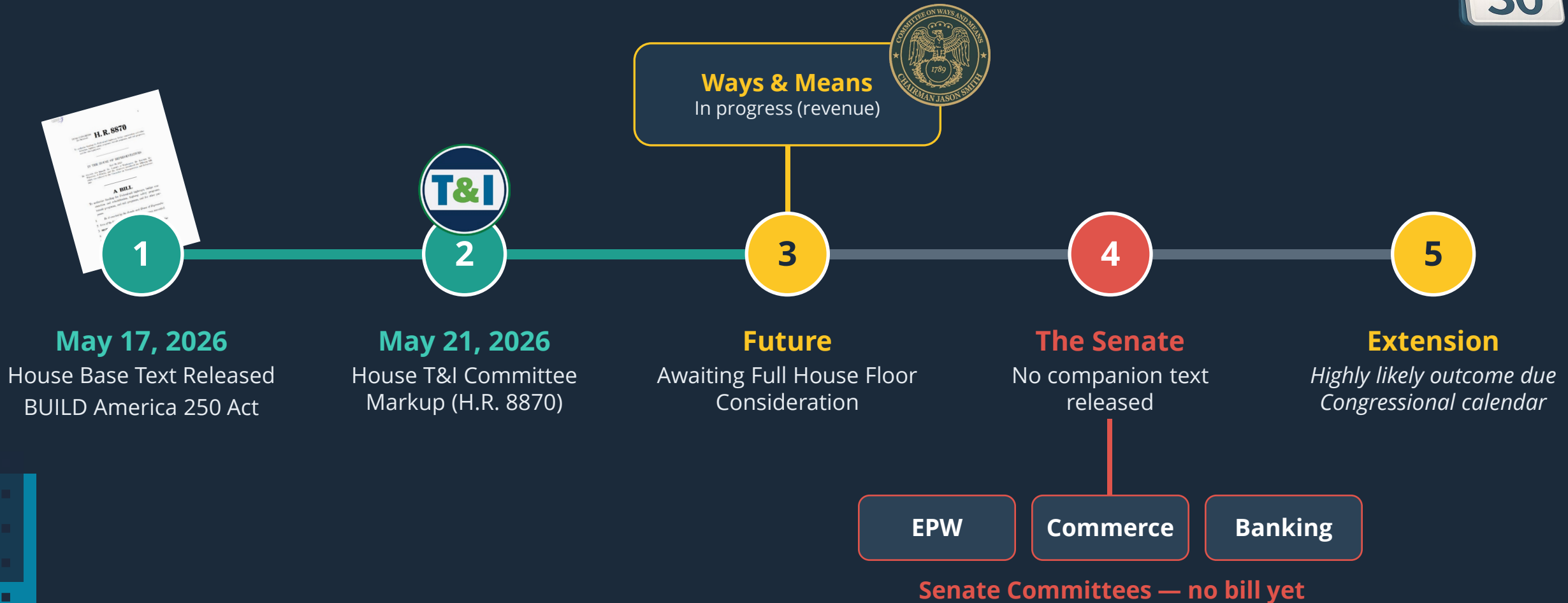

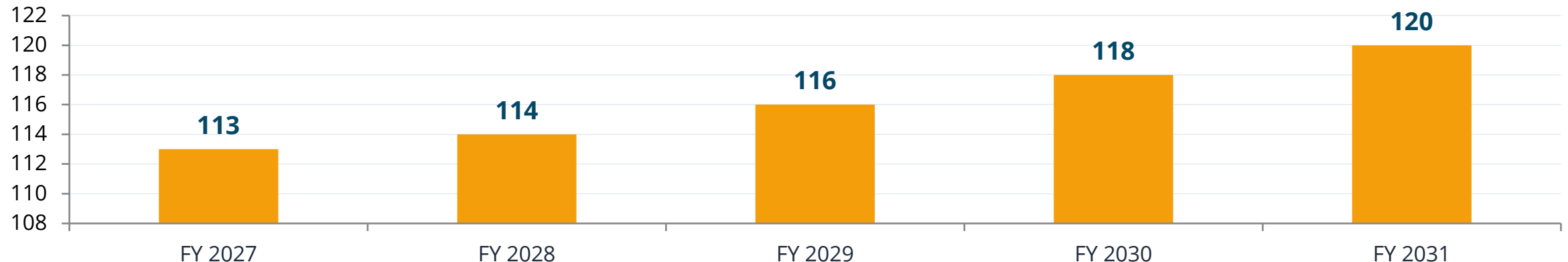

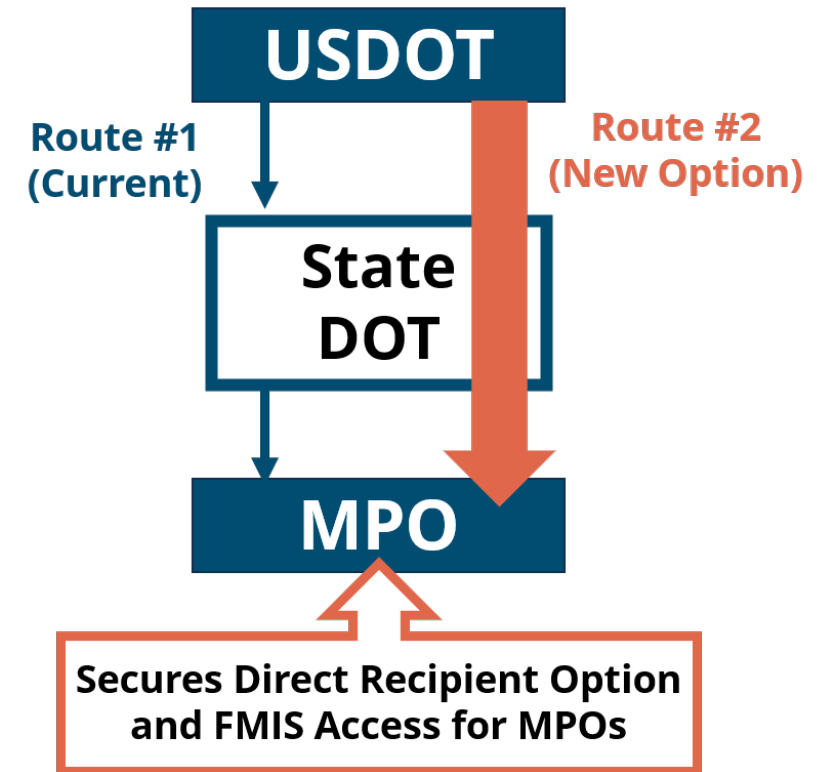

What to Watch & Next Steps

WATCH CLOSELY

Consolidated Funding Pilot

Up to 10 states receive a lump-sum block grant. MPOs must be consulted on local fund distribution — but consultation ≠ veto.

CRP Eliminated

Carbon Reduction Program ends FY27. Most projects remain eligible under STBG and CMAQ.

CMAQ Alt-Fuel Set-Aside

10% of CMAQ must fund alternative fueling in FY27, declining to 7% by FY30. Could reduce dollars available for regional priorities.

RTPO Funding Not Included in BA250

The Local Officials in Transportation (LOT) Coalition's BASICS Act (H.R. 7437) RTPO proposal (\$150M/yr, 100% federal) was not included in BA250. The LOT Coalition continues to support its addition in the Senate.

✓ **AMPO's RECOMMENDED ACTIONS**

1 Educate your Congressional Delegation

Educate your delegation on BA250 wins including, planning fund improvements, local match reductions, local safety and bridge funding, increased flexible STBG funding.

2 Build on the Base

The reauthorization process is a long timeline. Continue educating your Delegation on the importance of meaningful support for regions/locals. Flag any concerning elements.

3 Follow the Process

AMPO has lots of resources surrounding national and federal updates on the federal surface transportation reauthorization process. Follow our newsletter and reach out with questions

3 Work with your National Organizations

AMPO as well as the LOT coalition (NLC, NACo, USCM, NADO, NARC, and NADO) have resources to help support local and regional engagement in the reauthorization process.

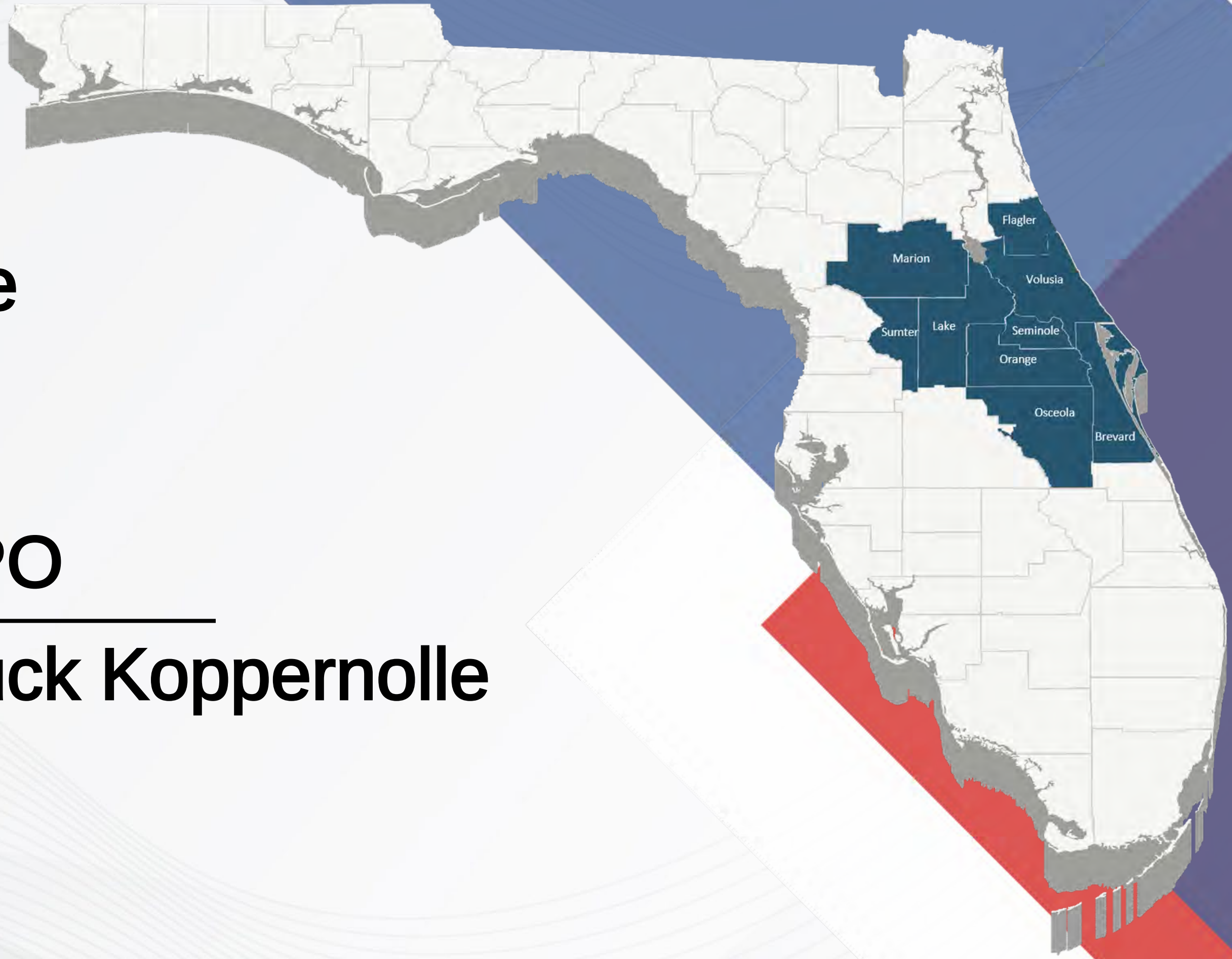

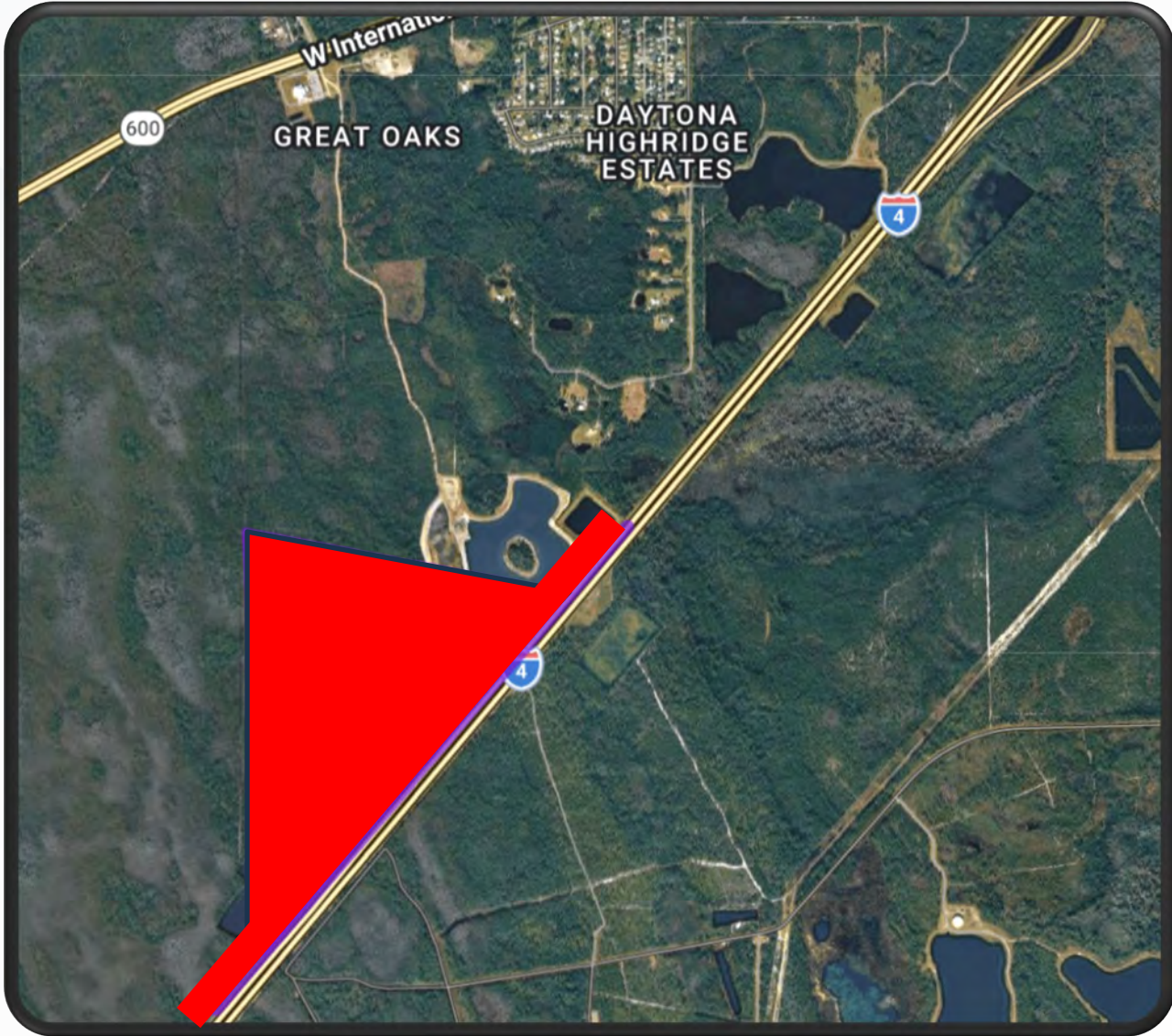

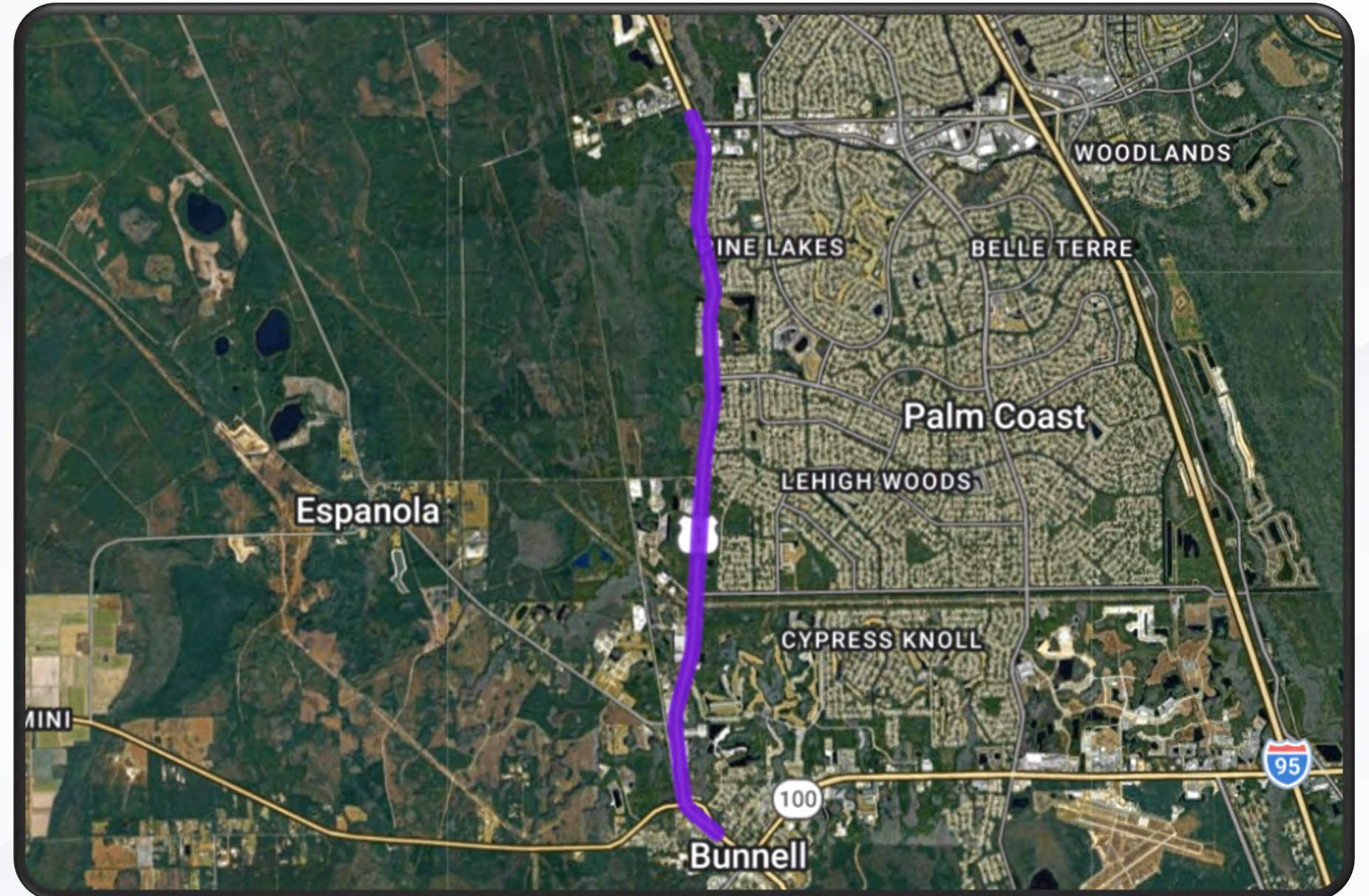
