



**Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Subcommittee
Meeting Summary
October 13, 2015**

- Approved a motion to recommend that the Regionally Significant Non-SIS Roadways Priority List and the Major Bridges Priority List be combined into one Priority Project List
- Approved a motion to recommend that the Traffic Operations/Safety Projects Priority List, Local Initiatives Priority List, Bicycle/Pedestrian Projects Priority List and the Transportation Alternatives Program Priority List be combined into one Priority Project List
- Approved a motion to recommend that all Traffic Operations/Safety projects, Local Initiatives projects, Bicycle/Pedestrian projects and Transportation Alternatives Program projects will require a 10% local match
- Approved a motion to recommend that all planning study applications should reflect consistency with the Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) and no other planning studies will be considered
- Approved a motion to recommend that a qualified project manager is required to be identified at the time of application for a feasibility study
- Reached a general consensus to have TPO staff provide a starting point for creating a minimum point threshold for qualifying projects
- Reached a general consensus for the TPO staff to formulate recommended funding caps for projects

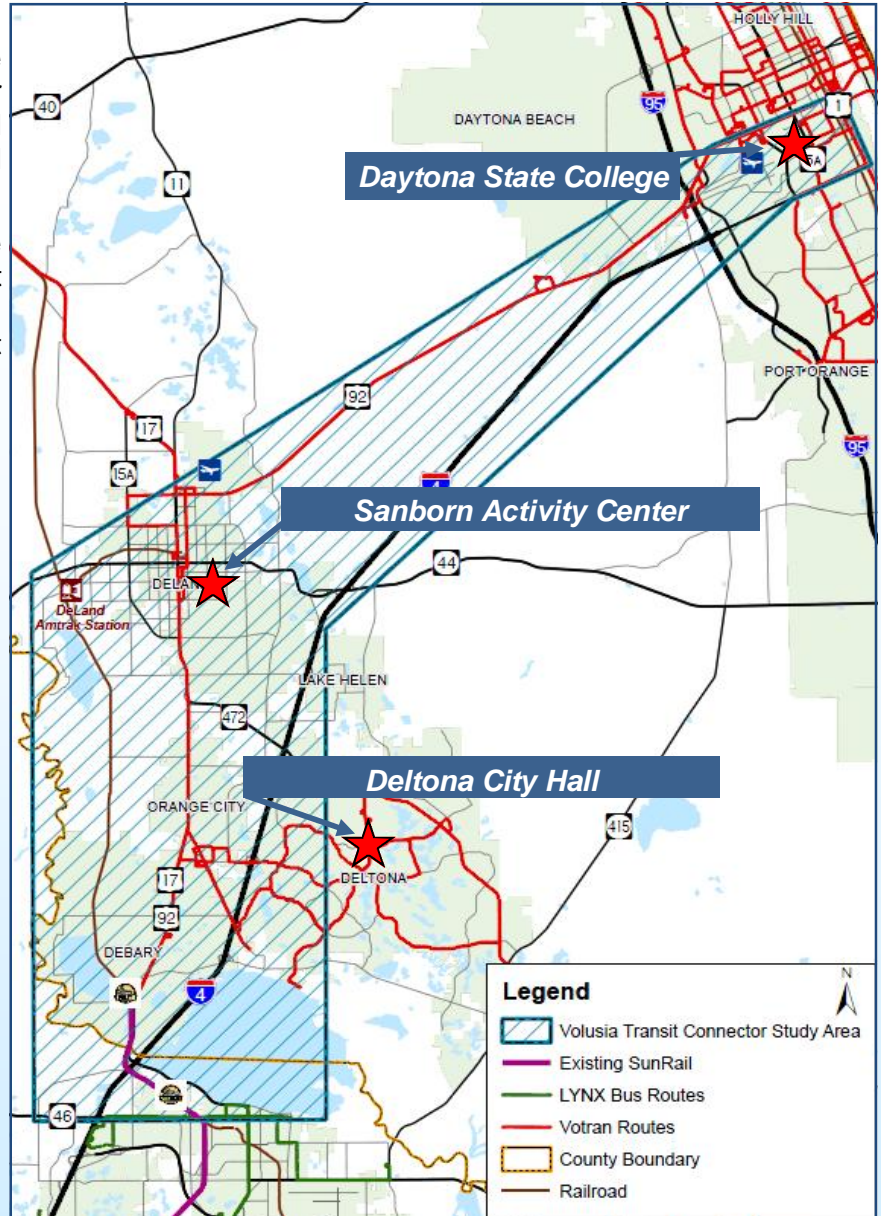
