**RESOLUTION OF THE VOLUSIA COUNTY METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION AMENDING THE
FISCAL YEAR FY 2009/10 TO FY 2013/14 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Volusia County MPO is the duly designated and constituted body responsible for carrying out the urban transportation planning process for Volusia County, and Flagler Beach and Beverly Beach in Flagler County; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes 33.175; 23 U.S.C. 134; and 40 U.S.C. 1602(a)(2), 1603(a), and 1604(g)1 and (1) require that the urbanized area, as a condition to the receipt of federal capital or operating assistance, have a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process that results in plans and programs consistent with the comprehensively planned development of the urbanized area; and

WHEREAS, 23 C.F.R. 450.114 provides that the MPO shall annually endorse the plans and programs by 23 C.F.R. 450.114 through 450.118, among which is the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and

WHEREAS, the Volusia County MPO's adopted TIP is required to be consistent with the Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT's) adopted Work Program; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation District V has requested a TIP amendment to accommodate a safety project; and

WHEREAS, the Volusia County MPO anticipates an additional stimulus or jobs bill

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Volusia County MPO that:

1. The Volusia County MPO's adopted FY 2009/10 to FY 2013/14 TIP shall be amended by adding project FM# 4281981 – Railroad crossing safety project; and adding a bridge replacement project (FM# 4270131) as a candidate project for the new stimulus/jobs bill.
2. The Chair of the MPO (or his/her designee) is hereby authorized and directed to submit this amendment to:
 - a. the State and Regional Clearinghouse Offices;
 - b. the Florida Department of Transportation;
 - c. the Federal Transit Administration;

- d. the Federal Highway Administration (through the Florida Department of Transportation);
- e. the East Central Florida Regional Planning Council (ECFRPC);
- f. the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA); and
- g. the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA);

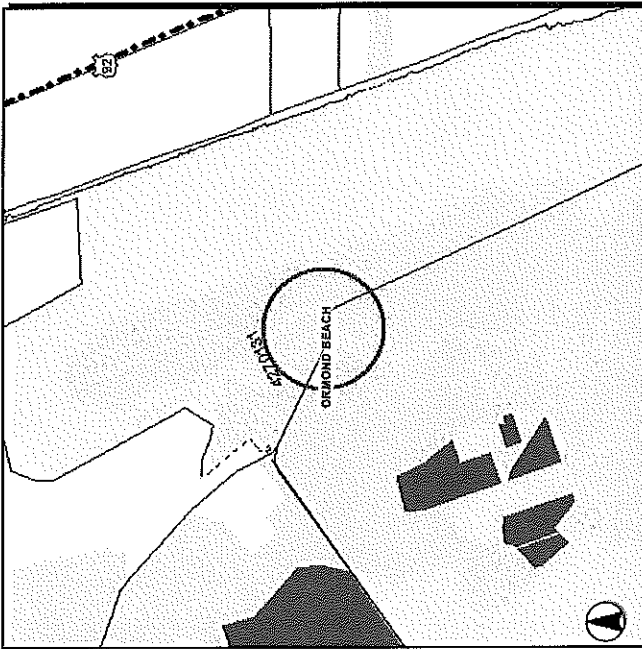

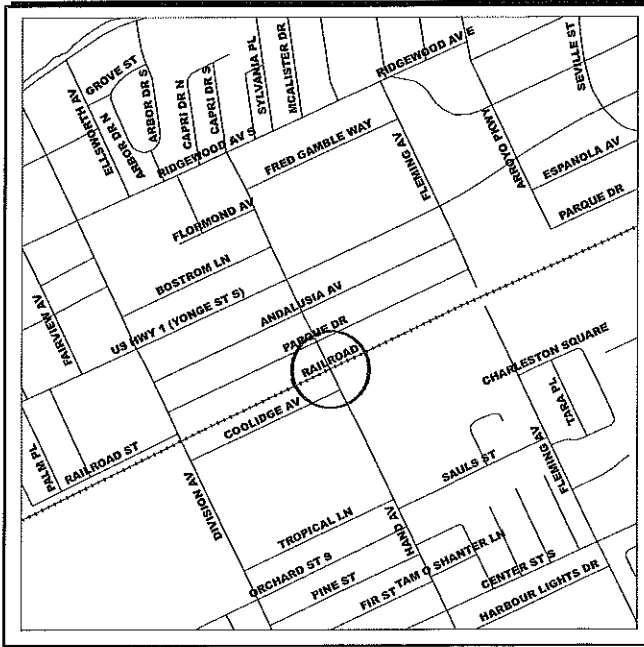
