

## RIVER TO SEA TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION

### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the River to Sea Transportation Planning Organization (R2CTPO) will conduct a public hearing at its regular TPO Board meeting on Wednesday, January 27, 2016 at 9:00 a.m. in the River to Sea TPO Conference room located at 2570 W. International Speedway Blvd. Suite 100, Daytona Beach, FL. The purpose of the hearing is to receive public input regarding the draft report for the **2040 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP)**. Public comments are welcomed and encouraged during the public hearing or they may be submitted directly to the TPO office prior to the public hearing.

The LRTP is a 25-year projection to identify strategies that satisfy the transportation needs of the R2CTPO Metropolitan Planning Area (MPA). This MPA encompasses all of Volusia County and portions of Flagler County inclusive of the cities of Flagler Beach, Beverly Beach, and portions of Palm Coast and Bunnell. Projects selected for inclusion in the R2CTPO's 2040 LRTP are intended to reflect the vision and goals of the MPA and its member governments.

The LRTP is the guiding document that identifies needed transportation projects and the anticipated federal and state funds that will support their development. This is the final public hearing before the adoption of the 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP).
