The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing to enhance Oakridge Boulevard in the City of Daytona Beach by providing the following improvements within FDOT's existing right of way:

- · Reducing the number of lanes from three to two
- Adding a 7-foot buffered bike lane, and
- Milling and resurfacing the existing pavement

Attendees may come any time between 5 p.m. and 7 p.m. to review project displays, hold one-on-one conversations with FDOT staff and/or representatives, and watch a presentation video that will run on a continuous loop. Project aerials and virtual reality devices will be used to provide visualization of the proposed improvements.
