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SR 15A (TAYLOR ROAD) ACCESS MANAGEMENT

Project Purpose and Need:

The purpose of this project on SR 15A from SR 15 (US 17/92) to west of S. Adelle Avenue is to replace the existing two way left turn lane with a curbed raised median including Left turn lanes and update the corridor using current access management criteria. It will include installation of a signalized intersection at South Clara Avenue, resurfacing the roadway, signing and pavement marking, and drainage work. This project will not require right-of-way acquisition.

Pedestrian features will be added to the all quadrants of the newly signalized intersection at South Clara Avenue. Two U-turn aprons will be provided to accommodate larger vehicles at proposed directional median openings.

SR 15A within the limits of this project is defined by a mix of urban residential and commercial uses in DeLand, Florida. The roadway has been recommended for these safety improvements via the SR 15A Intersection Safety Study.
