



S.R. 415 Improvements from North of Acorn Lake Road to S.R. 44

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is planning roadway improvements along State Road (S.R.) 415 from north of Acorn Lake Road to S.R. 44.

The purpose of this project is to repave the travel lanes and shoulders along this 10-mile segment of S.R. 415 to improve the driving surface and extend the life of the existing roadway. The project also plans to widen a section of S.R. 415 to accommodate a new southbound left-turn lane onto Quail Ranch Road. The right turn lane from northbound S.R. 415 to eastbound S.R. 44 will also be lengthened.

To enhance safety, the project will also improve the slope of the road in some areas to help minimize ponding when it rains. This improvement will require FDOT to reconstruct a portion of some driveways to maintain a good connection to the roadway. The project also plans to place additional asphalt at some unpaved side streets to improve safety for vehicles turning onto S.R. 415.
