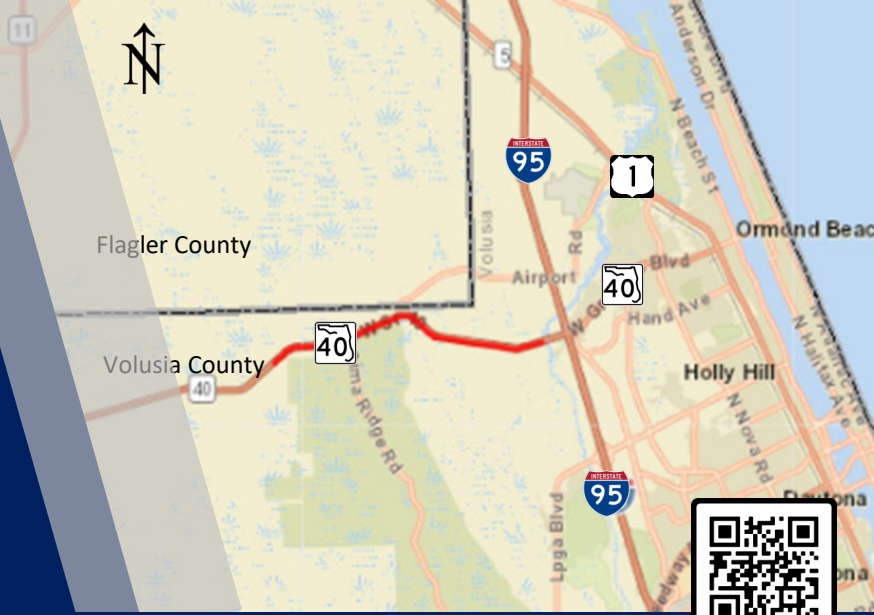




S.R. 40 Resurfacing From East of Rodeo Road to Bayberry Drive

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is designing improvements along State Road (S.R.) 40 from east of Rodeo Road to Bayberry Drive in Ormond Beach. The purpose of the project is to enhance safety and operations along the corridor. The project will resurface this segment of S.R. 40 to extend the life of the existing roadway. Other improvements include enhancing lighting at intersections with crosswalks, pedestrian curb ramp reconstruction in accordance with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) guidelines and installing additional signage and new pavement marking features.

The segment of S.R. 40 included in this project borders the cities of Daytona Beach and Ormond Beach. Currently, S.R. 40 transitions from a two-lane roadway at the western limits to a four-lane divided roadway just west of Pinto Lane. State Road 40 is a designated evacuation route.
