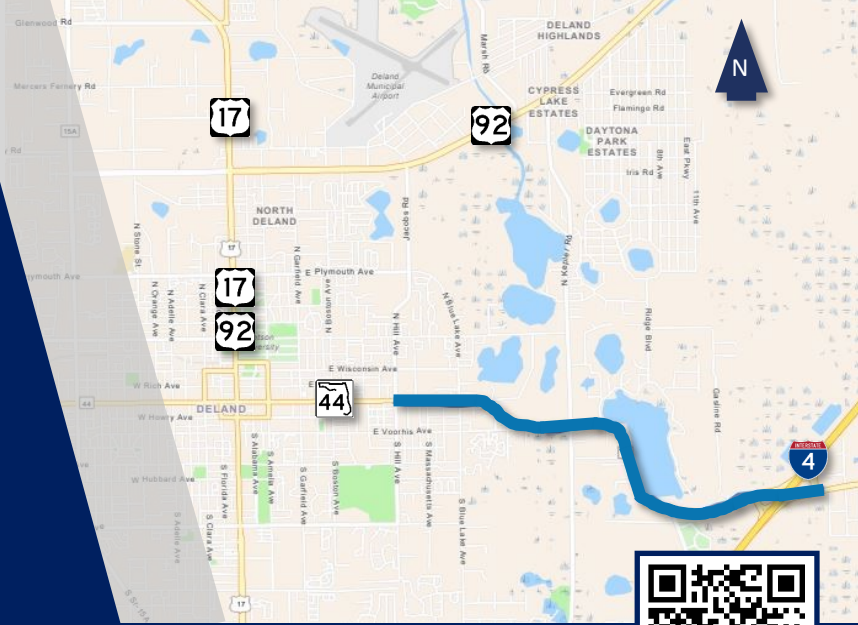




S.R. 44 Resurfacing from N. Hill Avenue to Eastbound I-4 On Ramp

Volusia County

Project Description

This project extends nearly 3.8 miles along State Road (S.R.) 44 from N. Hill Avenue to the eastbound Interstate 4 (I-4) on ramp. The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proposing the project to provide safety and mobility improvements along the corridor.

The project will repave this segment of S.R. 44 to extend the life of the existing roadway. Pedestrian improvements are also planned, including upgrading pedestrian signals, enhancing intersection lighting, and reconstructing the sidewalk curb ramps to comply with current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards. Other improvements that will improve safety and operations include slope corrections at two curves, guardrail upgrades at the I-4 overpass, and drainage modifications. Bicycle lanes will be provided by pavement widening on the shoulders. The project excludes the project limits of a proposed roundabout at the intersection of S.R. 44 and Kepler Road, which is being designed under FPID number 431922-1.
