



S.R. A1A Safety Improvements

from north of Ocean Marina Drive to south of Westmayer Place

Project Description

This Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) project will enhance vehicle and pedestrian safety in the Town of Beverly Beach by implementing the recommendations of a 2019 State Road (S.R.) A1A Pedestrian Safety Study.

S.R. A1A will be repaved from north of Shelter Cove Drive to south of Westmayer Place. Additionally, the project will construct raised medians from the Beverly Beach Town Hall to just south of Luta Lane, and the addition of a left turn lane from northbound S.R. A1A to Surfside Estates.

Pedestrian safety will be improved by reconstructing and upgrading the mid-block crossing at the Beverly Beach Camptown RV Resort with landscaping and lighting to increase visibility of the crosswalk. The Department also is considering pedestrian activated lights to further increase driver awareness and visibility at the crosswalk. The project will also reconstruct existing sidewalk and add about 465 feet of new sidewalk south of the new crossing.

Other improvements include upgrading driveway connections, and improving drainage.

The planned improvements will affect some parking areas near the Beverly Beach Town Hall and beach access.
