

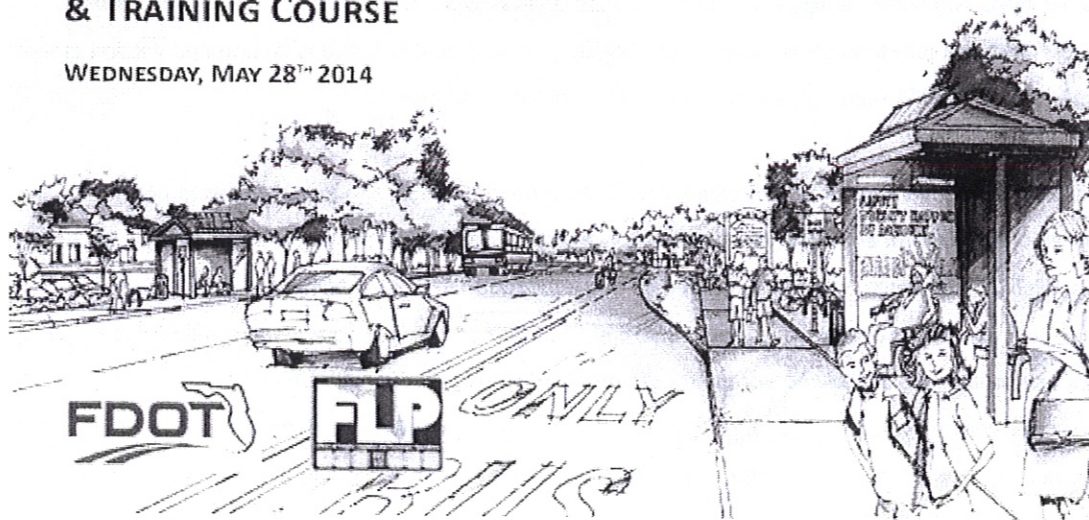

## BUS FACILITY DESIGN HANDBOOK & TRAINING COURSE

WEDNESDAY, MAY 28<sup>TH</sup> 2014



The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Transit Office is sponsoring a training opportunity for state and local staff who approve, permit, design, and/or place transit facilities within roadway rights-of-way. This course is built around the updated [Accessing Transit: Design Handbook for Florida Bus Passenger Facilities, Version III, 2013.](#)

If your responsibilities impact State rights-of-way through designing, operating, building, or maintaining bus stops, stations, and facilities, you are invited to attend this free training session the Transit Office is conducting in Orlando.

This session is scheduled at the FDOT District Five Urban Offices, 133 South Semoran Boulevard, Orlando, Florida, Apopka Conference Rooms A and B; from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM on Wednesday May 28, 2014.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** The course is based on the FDOT Transit Office's Accessing Transit: Design Handbook for Florida Bus Passenger Facilities, Version III, 2013. and is an updated version of the course offered in 2011 featuring the previous version of the handbook.

*As public transit continues to be enhanced, FDOT departments and local agencies need to become better informed of the Federal and State laws, rules, design standards, and guidelines that impact their areas of responsibility. This course will include materials and information that are relevant to FDOT planning, design, and operations offices, local government engineering and permitting agencies, as well as local transit operators. Included will be access requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), design criteria along state roadways, guidance for reviewing design plans, and improving pedestrian safety at bus stops. User-friendly reference and resource materials will supplement the instruction and be available prior to the training.*
