RESOLUTION OF THE RIVER TO SEA TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION ADOPTING THE PARATRANSIT SERVICE ANALYSIS REPORT

WHEREAS Florida Statutes 339.175; 23 U.S.C. 134; and 49 U.S.C. 5303 require that the urbanized area, as a condition to the receipt of federal capital or operating assistance, have a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process that results in plans and programs consistent with the comprehensively planned development of the urbanized area; and

WHEREAS, the River to Sea Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) is the duly designated and constituted body responsible for carrying out the urban transportation planning and programming process for Volusia County and portions of Flagler County inclusive of the cities of Flagler Beach, Beverly Beach, and portions of Palm Coast and Bunnell; and

Whereas, the River to Sea TPO has developed the Paratransit Service Analysis Report to identify changes in the paratransit service industry that have had a positive or negative impact on efficiencies in service provision and on budgets; and

WHEREAS, the Paratransit Service Analysis Report has been provided for review by the general public, the River to Sea TPO's Advisory Committees, and the River to Sea TPO Board.

Now, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the River to Sea TPO that the:

- 1. The River to Sea TPO Board and advisory committees have reviewed and adopted the River to Sea TPO's Paratransit Service Analysis Report; and the
- 2. River to Sea TPO's Paratransit Service Analysis Report is attached hereto as Attachment "A"; and the
- 3. The Chairperson of the River to Sea TPO (or her designee) is hereby authorized and directed to submit the Paratransit Service Analysis Report to the:
 - a. Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged;
 Florida Department of Transportation;
 - b. Federal Transit Administration (FTA) (through the Florida Department of Transportation); and the
 - c. Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) (through the Florida Department of Transportation); and the
 - d. Northeast Florida Regional Council (NEFRC).
