RESOLUTION OF THE RIVER TO SEA TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION ADOPTING THE FEDERAL FUNCTIONAL CLASSIFICATION MAPS OF ROADWAYS FOR VOLUSIA AND FLAGLER COUNTIES

WHEREAS, the River to Sea Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) is the duly designated and constituted body responsible for carrying out the urban transportation planning and programming process for Volusia County and portions of Flagler County inclusive of the cities of Flagler Beach, Beverly Beach, and portions of Palm Coast and Bunnell; and

Whereas, Florida Statutes 339.175; 23 U.S.C. 134; and 49 U.S.C. 5303 require that the urbanized area, as a condition to the receipt of federal capital or operating assistance, have a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process that results in plans and programs consistent with the comprehensively planned development of the urbanized area; and

WHEREAS, this urban transportation planning process includes the review and adoption of Functional Classification of roadways upon completion of each decennial U.S. Census; and

WHEREAS, the River to Sea TPO has coordinated with FDOT, local jurisdictions and TPO committees on the update and review of the Functional Classifications and have agreed to the classifications.

Now, Therefore, Be IT RESOLVED, by the River to Sea TPO that the:

- 1. River to Sea TPO hereby adopts the 2020 Functional Classification of Public Roadways Map for Volusia County as indicated in Attachment "A"; and the
- 2. River to Sea TPO hereby adopts the 2020 Functional Classification of Public Roadways Map for Flagler County as indicated in Attachment "B"; and the
- 3. Chairperson of the River to Sea TPO (or his designee) is hereby authorized and directed to submit the 2020 Functional Classification of Public Roadways Maps for Volusia County (Attachment "A") and Flagler County (Attachment "B") to the:
 - a. Florida Department of Transportation:
 - b. Federal Transit Administration (FTA) (through the Florida Department of Transportation); and
 - c. Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) (through the Florida Department of Transportation).
