Federal Certification


• No less than once every 4 years FTA & FHWA jointly review the metropolitan transportation planning process for those areas over 200,000 in population (TMAs).

Public Input

• To solicit your comments and perspectives regarding the transportation planning and programming process, as carried out by the River to Sea TPO and our partners.

Role of the River to Sea TPO

- Required by federal and state law for urbanized areas (UZA) with a population greater than 50,000
- Ensures that expenditures of public funds for transportation are based on a <u>continuing</u>, <u>cooperative and comprehensive</u> planning process
- Provides local input in the prioritization of transportation projects utilizing state and federal funding


