## **PEDAL POWER: BICYCLE SAFETY TAKES THE SPOTLIGHT AT NEW SMYRNA BEACH LIBRARY**

On Friday morning, July 11, the Volusia-Flagler TPO hosted a bicycle safety program at the New Smyrna Beach Public Library for local children and teens.

The session included an educational video and an interactive presentation focused on safe riding habits, the importance of helmet use, and tips for navigating streets and sidewalks safely. Following the presentation, each participant received a properly fitted bicycle helmet.

A total of 21 children were fitted with new helmets, reinforcing the importance of safety gear and helping ensure they're better protected while riding.

The event was part of the TPO's ongoing community outreach to promote safe and active transportation throughout the region.

## National Stop on Red Week

In recognition of National Stop on Red Week, taking place August 3–9, the Florida Department of Transportation’s District Five Office of Safety is partnering with the Volusia-Flagler TPO and the National Coalition for Safer Roads (NCSR) to raise awareness about the life-threatening risks of red light running.

Crashes caused by drivers running red lights are often violent, resulting in severe injuries or worse. In 2023 alone, the most recent year with complete data, Florida recorded 33,045 such crashes, resulting in 84 fatalities and 681 serious injuries. (FLHSMV, Traffic Crash Facts, Annual Report 2023)

On Thursday, August 7, a Stop on Red event and press conference will be held at the intersection of International Speedway Blvd & Beach Street in Daytona Beach. The event will run from 9:00 am - 10:30 am. More info: [Click Here](#)
