Dear Government Partner,

I invite you to the public kickoff meeting for the 5th Street Bridge Replacement design project. The meeting will be held as an open house, and the public is welcome to attend anytime between 5 p.m. and 7 p.m. Thursday, November 1, at the Smyrna Yacht Club, 1201 South Riverside Drive, New Smyrna Beach, Florida 32168.

The purpose of the meeting is to introduce the city's design project to replace the 5th Street bridge (Bridge No. 795701) over Yacht Club Cut. A looping presentation will provide an overview of the project, and design team members will be available to discuss the project and answer questions.

The goal of the project is to design a new bridge structure with two 9-foot-wide travel lanes and 2.5-foot shoulders on each side. The project will include reconstructing the bridge approaches and guardrail. All work will be performed within the existing City of New Smyrna Beach right of way. A temporary bridge will be installed to maintain access to and from Riverside Drive and the island during construction.

Public participation in this project is solicited without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sex, religion, disability or family status.
