**We have received the following questions regarding the RFP for the Traffic Operations/ITS/Safety Feasibility Studies. Details regarding the Schedule, Scope of Work, and Selection Process can be found in the RFP and Scope of Services.**

1. **Question:** Is the number of projects (4) under related experience, just for the Prime firm or for all subs as well?

**Response:** Previous work products are required for the prime consultant.

2. **Question:** Are the references under section 5, just references for the Prime firm or for all subs as well?

**Response:** References are required for the prime consultant and each sub-consultant.

3. **Question:** Who is on the selection committee for this RFP?

**Response:** Selection Committee Members are: Chris Nabicht (R2CTPO Board Member), Jose Papa (TCC Member), Vince Wang (R2CTPO Staff), and Colleen Nicoulin (R2CTPO Staff). A non-voting advisor from FDOT, District 5 Traffic Operations will also be on the Selection Committee. Keep in mind, the *No Contact Provision* on Page 5 of the RFP applies to the Selection Committee.

4. **Question:** Is there any extension of deadline?

**Response:** There is no extension of submittal deadline. Proposals, as outlined in the RFP, must be received by the R2CTPO no later than **November 21, 2017 at 12:00 p.m. (noon) E.S.T.** Proposals received after this date and time **WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**
