**RESOLUTION OF THE VOLUSIA TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION  
AMENDING THE LIST OF PRIORITY PROJECTS FOR XU BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN SET-ASIDE  
PROJECTS TO INCLUDE THE FLAGLER BEACH DOWNTOWN STREETScape, PHASE II-C  
AND THE US-1 SIDEWALKS IN EDGEWATER**

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**WHEREAS**, the Volusia Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) is the duly designated and constituted body responsible for carrying out the urban transportation planning and programming process for Volusia County and the cities of Flagler Beach and Beverly Beach in Flagler County; and

**WHEREAS**, Florida Statutes 339.175; 23 U.S.C. 134; 49 U.S.C. 5303; require that the urbanized area, as a condition to the receipt of federal capital or operating assistance, have a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process that results in plans and programs consistent with the comprehensively planned development of the urbanized area; and

**WHEREAS**, the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA) of 1991, the Transportation Equity Act for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century (TEA-21) of 1998, and the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: a Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) of August 2005 have increased the role and responsibilities of metropolitan planning organizations especially with respect to establishing local government transportation project priorities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Volusia TPO annually engages in an open, cooperative process with the local governments and the Florida Department of Transportation, which includes a public hearing to develop the priority project lists; and

**WHEREAS**, the priority project lists are known to be consistent with the Volusia TPOs 2035 Long Range Transportation Plan;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Volusia Transportation Planning Organization that the:

1. Volusia TPO hereby endorses and amends the List of Priority Projects for XU Bicycle/Pedestrian Set-Aside Projects to include the Flagler Beach Downtown Streetscape, Phase II-C and the Right-of-Way Certification for the US-1 sidewalks project in the City of Edgewater as Tier 2 projects (projects with completed studies awaiting programming or commitments for local matching funds);

2. Volusia TPO Chairman, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to submit this resolution to:
  - a. the State and Regional Clearinghouse Offices;
  - b. the Florida Department of Transportation;
  - c. the Federal Transit Administration (through the Florida Department of Transportation);
  - d. the Federal Highway Administration (through the Florida Department of Transportation);
  - e. the East Central Florida Regional Planning Council;
  - f. the Federal Aviation Administration;
  - g. the Environmental Protection Agency;
  - h. the Division of Resource Planning & Management, Department of Community Affairs.
