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TRAIL ADVOCATES AND THE PUBLIC ARE INVITED TO ATTEND THE 2013 ST. JOHNS RIVER TO THE SEA LOOP TRAIL SUMMIT

Local, state and federal entities as well as non-profits, business interests and advocates are invited to attend this year's St. Johns River to the Sea Loop Trail Summit, a forum for strategic planning for the trail. This year's event will be held in Marineland, Florida at the Whitney Laboratory for Marine Bioscience. Summit topics include: trails funding, closing trail gaps and benefits of trail projects.

The St. Johns River to the Sea Loop is envisioned as the longest multi-use loop trail in the southeast United States and will serve a diverse range of non-motorized transportation activities. The loop trail will traverse 300 miles across Brevard, Flagler, Putnam, St. Johns and Volusia Counties. This year's summit venue is located along Flagler County's segment of the trail, so bicyclists, pedestrians, wheelchair users, in-line skaters, joggers with strollers and skateboarders will be able to access and enjoy the trail before and after the event.
