 - Add equestrian trails in Osteen
 - Safe connection to Valentine Park in Orange City
 - Add trail rules signs trail etiquette
 - Add more loop trails like Lake Beresford Park loop
 - Improve awareness
 - Add charging stations for e-bikes and electric mobility devices


- Suggested additions to the Trail Master Plan
 - Provide educational programs
 - Add bridge or tunnel to cross SR 44 from Lake Beresford Park to Grand Ave.
 - Add restrooms between Debary and Orange City
 - Add trail from Tomoka State Park, BennyWoodham Trail to Sanchez Park
 - Add lights to trails for night use in winter months
 - Trail connection to Riverwalk Park to Ormond Beach
 - Repave Willow Run and connect it along Williamson Blvd.


- Suggested additions to the Trail Master Plan

 - Add trail along US 92 to Daytona Beach
 - Farmton provided the county with their trail alignment






























How do you typically travel to Volusia County's trails?






Would you use the trail system to reach SunRail stations?






