Public feedback sought for US 92 Corridor Master Management Plan

Volusia County – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is hosting the second public meeting to get citizen feedback, and to provide information, about the development of a Corridor Master Management Plan for US 92 (International Speedway Boulevard) from Interstate 4 (I-4) to State Road (SR) A1A (Atlantic Avenue) in Daytona Beach.

The study includes improvements to traffic flow along the corridor, updating transportation needs with the city's core areas, improving bicycle and pedestrian safety, and promoting business growth within Daytona Beach and Volusia County.

The meeting is an **open house from 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, July 28, 2015**, at Daytona State College, 1200 West International Speedway Boulevard, Daytona Beach, Florida 32114, in Building 110 (Bergengren Hall), Room 112. There will be a presentation at **6:00 p.m.**

The purpose of this meeting is to present, discuss, and gather public input on the potential alternatives being considered. Maps, drawings and other pertinent information will be on display for public review and the Study Team will be available to answer questions.
