
- Gas Taxes 15 cents / gallon includes 5 cents specifically for construction of capacity projects. (County wide)
- Impact Fees Generated by new development can only be used for new capacity in that particular impact fee zone. (Zones)
- Proportionate Fair Share Development driven funding for impacts created by their development in congested areas. (Zones)
- Bond Fully Committed FY 03/04 \$65M Road Bond. (County wide)
- **Grants** State/Federal project grants, e.g., LAP & TRIP. (County wide)
